From its inception in 2008 the Bangkok Supercup has grown to become one of the top International Youth Football Tournaments in Asia. Now in its 18th year, the competition targets elite level teams and offers academies a unique opportunity to compete against some of the regions top teams at the bi-annual event, June's tournament features teams from u8, u10, u12, u14 & u16 age groups while December's Winter Edition of the Bangkok Supercup features the u7, u9, u11, u13 & u15 age groups.

In June 2026 iPlay Soccer Schools will host the Winter Edition of the Bangkok International Supercup. Kicking off early Saturday morning, we are once again privileged to use the extensive facilities of the Thailand FA's National Training Centre at Nong Chok.

The tournament will finish at 3:30pm on Sunday afternoon and will be followed by the trophy presentation to all teams.

Similar to the December (Winter) Edition, the competition is expected to feature over 1200 players but as always we won't let that impact the quality of the footballing experience. In fact, the Summer Edition of the tournament will feature even more football than ever, with all teams playing a minimum of eight games over the course of the weekend.

We hope that by focusing on creating a top quality football experience for all participants, we will continue towards our goal to make the Bangkok Supercup the number one youth tournament in Asia.

All games in the Bangkok Supercup 2026 will be held at the Thai FA's National Training Centre at Nong Chok

Nong Chok National Football Centre is the Football Association of Thailand national football centre on a 80-acre (32 ha) site at Nong Chok, Bangkok

The center was officially opened by Sepp Blatter, former president of FIFA on 16 September 2009.

The centre houses approx. 50 rooms, including four dormitories, 5 grass training pitches, Nong Chok Sport Stadium, Medical Center, Fitness Center, Swimming pool and an artificial training pitch
